Robert Buchner Well-known Florida Bridge Teacher and Mentor

Bob has been playing this amazing game of bridge for 60 years and teaching for about 14 years. He is a Sapphire Life Master with about 6,300 master points. Bob worked as an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Florida and retired about 19 years ago.

He teaches and plays at the Pompano Beach Duplicate Bridge Club located at the Skolnick Center in Pompano Beach. His classes are on Wednesday mornings and students are welcome to stay after class, have a light lunch, chat about all things bridge, and play in the "Open" game for free.

He speaks about the process of teaching and helping people learn, so he begins his classes by putting two hands on a "white board" for the students to solve. He talks about his goals for students, such as the need to graduate from playing trick-to-trick to making an overall plan for making the contract and over tricks. After the class has been shown an understanding of both hands, he discusses a single topic each week. For example: take-out doubles and overcalls, Stayman and transfers of partner's opening NT bid, pre-empts at the 2, 3 and 4 levels, negative doubles, Two-Over-One bidding with forcing NT, opening leads against suit and NT contracts, balancing, Jacoby raises of partner's opening major suit bid, and more. He teaches each class for about 45 minutes with the balance being supervised bridge play. He finds immense satisfaction that several of his students have progressed and are now playing in either the "Open" game or Intermediate games.

Bruce's Bridge Journey:

I never played bridge until 2012. After sitting in for an aunt as dummy who needed to take a phone call, I was hooked. When I got home, I downloaded bridge base and started to practice. When just learning the game, I didn't understand why others were able to garner more tricks than I did in a particular contract. Being a person who likes to be successful, this issue motivated me to study, learn, and forge special bridge partnerships that helped me attain my bridge goals. My proudest accomplishment has been coming in second place at two NABC+ events. These events demanded playing 3 days of platinum pairs against some of the best players in the world. I've been playing professional bridge for the last 5 years and love this game as it enriches my life immeasurably.

In addition, Mr. Lang is part owner of Jourdan's bridge club in West Palm Beach and provides mentorship and lessons to many of the club's membership. In 1980 at the World Bridge Olympics in Valkenburg, Holland, Linda represented South Africa. At that point, bridge became a passion that has encompassed and enriched her life. Prior to this event, she was a Chief Medical Technologist in Clinical Pathology running a laboratory for a children's hospital in Johannesburg.

Shortly thereafter and for 42 years and counting, she teaches bridge classes to all levels of players. Once again in 1992 and 1993, she represented South Africa in world level competitions. After relocating to America in 1998, and being a World Olympic and International bridge player, she decided to become a bridge director and professional teacher.
